

Dear Mother Advisors,

Attached is a spread sheet for you to use during the 2008-2010 Rainbow Service Awards Program. This year the girls can earn butterfly charms and a bracelet to attach them. They will receive the bracelet when they earn the violet charm. They have to earn 10 hours of service for each color charm as follows:

Red – Love: Participate in a community event, such as special events that are city wide – walks for causes, cleaning up parks, streets, etc.

Orange – Religion: Attend religious services, participate in church related service activities.

Yellow – Nature: Assist your Mother Advisor in planning and preparing an outdoor Rainbow event in your area and attend the function.

Green – Immortality: Assist grandparents, board members, or someone who needs help doing yard work, ironing, etc. Working with special needs children would be an idea also.

Blue-Fidelity: Participate and attend a family event such as a reunion, anniversary, or special holiday by helping with planning and preparation.

Indigo – Patriotism: Assist the American Legion, Legion Auxilliary, or other military service organization with projects of their choice, such as aid to military families.

Violet – Service: Assist at a Masonic Organization's Fund Raiser or special project of their choice.

You are also receiving the handouts for the girls to fill out their activities and hours. I encourage you to remind them to fill these out and turn them in to you at the designated times. I am asking that you turn your orders in to me by the following dates: November 1, 2008, March 1, 2009, July 1, 2009, November 1, 2009, March 1, 2010, and July 1, 2010.

You are also receiving a tally sheet to keep track of what charms the girl earns and to keep track of when they are received. I encourage you to use a pencil on this form and if a girl has earned 7 hours during one of the quarters, mark that on your tally sheet, so that you have a record of what she has earned to be added to the next form she turns in.
